SAT or **ACT** – which should you take? Some students have significantly different scores on the SAT and the ACT exams. The ACT is an achievement test, measuring what a student has learned in school. The SAT is an aptitude test, testing reasoning and verbal abilities. The ACT has up to 5 components: English, Mathematics, Reading, Science, and an optional Writing Test. The SAT has 3 components: Critical Reading, Mathematics, and a required Writing Test. Most colleges accept either exam.

New this year, the WHS Academic Booster Club is offering a **Mock ACT** in addition to the **Mock SAT**. This means you can take either exam under real testing conditions, but without having your scores reported. You will receive your results at the **review session led by Kaplan on 2/22/12 at 6PM** in the media center. This will be a combined session for Mock ACT and Mock SAT test takers. At that time, you can decide which test is best for you. Students can register for one or both tests.
