

SAT/ACT PREP CLASS 2010

Sponsored by the Wheeler Academic Booster Club

The purpose of this prep class is to help increase your SAT/ACT test scores by teaching verbal and math strategies as well as tips for the writing section. Ideally, this course is meant to prepare you for the Fall 2010 SAT/ACTs. The course consists of six 2 hour classes taught at Wheeler High School on Sunday afternoons from 4:00 – 6:00 PM.

Class size is limited to **40 students**. The students are divided into two groups of 20 students for math and verbal instruction. All materials (except for pencils, paper, and calculators) are provided.
